**Remediation:** Document a Legitimate Interest Assessment. Minimise data collected. Disclose fraud detection in privacy policy.

**Detail:** Forter (Forter Inc) was detected on f943c7a9bc9a.cdn4.forter.com with 2 requests. Data collected: Device fingerprint, behavioural signals. Data transfer to: US. Device fingerprinting for fraud prevention may use legitimate interest (Art. 6(1)(f)) but requires a documented balancing test.

**Remediation:** Document a Legitimate Interest Assessment. Minimise data collected. Disclose fraud detection in privacy policy.

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## 8 Regulatory Context — GDPR

**Consent requirement:** Under GDPR Art. 6(1)(a), advertising and tracking technologies require prior, freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous consent.

**ePrivacy:** The ePrivacy Directive (Art. 5(3)) requires consent before reading or writing to terminal equipment, including cookies and similar identifiers.

**Session Replay:** Behavioural analytics/session replay tools may capture special category data and require explicit consent or documented legitimate interest.

**Data Transfers:** Transfers to third countries (e.g. USA) require adequate safeguards such as Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) per GDPR Chapter V.

**Transparency:** Data subjects must be informed of all processing activities including third-party data sharing (Art. 13/14).
